LICENCE TO OPERATE GAMING MACHINES

Pursuant to Section 56 of the Gambling Act 2003 ("the Act"), the Secretary for Internal Affairs hereby grants a Class 4 Operator's Licence to:

HUCKLEBERRYS SPORTS & CHARITABLE SOCIETY INC ("the corporate society")


authorising it to conduct Class 4 gambling by way of gaming machines for the sole objective of distributing the net proceeds from the gambling to the following authorised purpose(s):

1. DONATIONS TO AMATEUR SPORTS TEAMS AND CLUBS IN THE LOCAL AREA, COMPETING IN RECOGNISED LEAGUES AND TOURNAMENTS. GRANTS ONLY ISSUED TO SPORTS TEAMS AND CLUBS WHICH ARE FORMALLY ESTABLISHED AND/OR LEGALLY CONSTITUTED. GRANTS ISSUED FOR ACTUAL AND REASONABLE TRAVEL EXPENSES FOR GROUPS PARTICIPATING IN TOURNAMENTS WITH KINDRED GROUPS, SPORTS EQUIPMENT, PLAYING UNIFORMS AND GROUND HIRE. NO GRANT SHALL BE ISSUED TO ANY PLAYER OR TEAM COMPETING ON A PROFESSIONAL BASIS.
2. DONATIONS TO RECOGNISED CHARITABLE AND CULTURAL ORGANISATIONS WITHIN THE LOCAL COMMUNITY TO FURTHER THE OBJECTIVES OF THESE GROUPS.
3. DONATIONS FOR EDUCATIONAL ADVANCEMENT THROUGH GRANTS TO SCHOOLS OR OTHER EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTES FOR EQUIPMENT OR THE DEVELOPMENT OF BETTER STUDENT AMENITIES NOT COVERED BY GOVERNMENT FUNDING. THE ESTABLISHMENT OF STUDENT SCHOLARSHIPS, BURSARIES OR GRANTS TO ASSIST INDIVIDUAL STUDENTS IN THEIR GENERAL EDUCATION ADVANCEMENT OR FOR THE FURTHERING OF ACADEMIC SPECIALISATION, PROVIDED SUCH STUDENTS ARE SELECTED IN A FAIR AND OPEN MANNER AFTER PUBLIC ADVERTISING.
4. NO GRANT SHALL BE ISSUED TO ANY PARTY WHICH WILL RESULT IN COMMERCIAL ADVANTAGE, EITHER DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY, TO MEMBER SITES OF HUCKLEBERRY'S SPORTS AND CHARITABLE SOCIETY.

This licence is granted subject to the provisions of the Act, any regulations or game rules made under the Act, and the licence conditions included in or added to this licence. A breach of the Act, regulations, game rules or licence conditions may be an offence under the Act and may result in the suspension, cancellation, refusal to amend, or non-renewal of this licence.

The authority granted by this licence commences on 1 July 2011 and expires on 30 June 2012.

CLASS 4 OPERATOR'S LICENCE
CONDITIONS APPLYING TO HUCKLEBERRYS SPORTS & CHARITABLE SOCIETY INC

(Issued pursuant to Section 53 of the Gambling Act 2003)

Condition 1 - Payments from dedicated accounts:

- (1) The holder of a class 4 operator's licence must ensure that all payments made for the following purposes are paid from the licence holder's dedicated account or dedicated accounts established for the purposes of section 104 and section 105 of the Act:
 - (a) the actual, reasonable, and necessary costs (including prizes), levies, taxes incurred in conducting class 4 gambling; and
 - (b) the actual, reasonable, and necessary costs incurred in complying with:
 - (i) the Gambling Act or any other Act;
 - (ii) an operator's licence;
 - (iii) a venue licence;
 - (c) the application or distribution of net proceeds to or for the licence holder's authorised purposes;
- (2) All payments from the dedicated account or dedicated accounts must be paid by either:
 - (a) cheque made out in the name of the payee and crossed "Account Payee Only" or "Not Transferable"; or
 - (b) fully auditable direct bank payment.
